

LICENSED UTILITY LAYERS

SECTION 1.

Utility layers, registered plumbers and competent contractors may be licensed by the Department of Public Works as licensed utility layers, authorized to perform work in the Town of Acushnet, subject to compliance with the following requirements:

A. Applicants for licenses shall pay an application and filing fee of One Hundred and fifty (\$150.00) as licensed utility layer, payable to the Town of Acushnet, all of which will be refunded to the applicant if his application is refused.

B. Applicants for licenses shall file with the Director a **Certificate of Insurance in the sums of \$100,000/\$300,000** to cover property damage liability. In addition, a Certificate of Insurance covering Workman's Compensation shall be filed, all of which shall remain in full force and effect for a period of at least one year from date of approval. Said insurance shall indemnify the Town of Acushnet against any and all claims, liability or action for damage incurred on or in any way connected with performance of the work by a licensed utility layer, and for or by reason of any acts or omissions of said licensed drain layer in the performance of his work. Completed applications with required insurance will be submitted by the Department of Public Works for approval.

C. In addition, the licensed utility layer shall file with the Director proper and acceptable Performance and Guarantee Bond in the amount of \$5,000 to guarantee the satisfactory completion of his work. The bond to be posted will be one with adequate sureties or other security (such as deposit of a bank book, etc.) which shall be satisfactory to the Department of Public Works. The bond shall remain in full force and effect for a period of one year from the date of application.

SECTION 2.

All licenses expire July 1 and no licenses are transferable. The fee for renewal shall be one-hundred (\$100.00) which shall be due and payable on or before the date of issue.

SECTION 3

The Department of Public Works shall have the power to revoke licenses if any provisions of these rules and regulations are violated.

SECTION 4

All licenses are required to give personal attention to all installations and shall employ only competent workers.

SECTION 5

Under 248 Code of Massachusetts Regulations, Section 2:04 (2) master and journeyman Plumbers need not be licensed for these purposes but they will be required to obtain a permit to perform the work and shall provide the certificate of insurance and the performance/guarantee bond as set out in SECTION 1.
