Course Conditions

- The course is in good condition and has responded well to recent aerations and fertilizations in preparation for going into winter. Although, I am concerned about the saturated soils of both greens and fairways.
- Greens: We are experiencing a significant amount of wear on our greens at cupping areas, especially on holes 3 through 11, due to excessively wet soils, golf round numbers consistently in the 175 to 210 per day volume, and shade issues preventing some greens from drying down at this time of year. We will be implementing additional small tine aerations as well as topdressings to address the issue agronomically. To accomplish these aerations in a timely and efficient manner I am recommending the purchase of the Baroness FS900 Core Collector (price: \$35,000). We may also need to consider limiting rounds during the remainder of the season if the cycle of wet conditions continues.
- Fairways: Saturated soils combined with significant cart traffic have resulted in damage to fairways on holes 7, 9, 10, 13 (primarily in rough adjacent to the fairway on the right side) and 16. If the cycle of wet conditions persists we will have to institute cart path only restrictions. We should also limit single person cart use unless there is not an alternative (ie. 2 carts per foursome not 3 or 4).

> Equipment

- Our 300 gallon Smithco sprayer has been repaired and will be tested on Friday to make sure all components are in working order.
- Ventrac Rough Mower with attachments I introduced the Ventrac Rough Mower earlier this year as a replacement for our aging Toro 4500 Rough Mower (purchased in 2013 current hours = 4373). For the price of \$68,400.00 we would receive the tractor, a contour mowing deck, a "Tough Cut Mower" for cutting native areas, and a Boom Arm attachment for cutting pond embankments and steep tee embankments such as that on the 16th hole. We would also have the opportunity to acquire additional attachments in the future. Ventrac units are available within 5 to 6 weeks after ordering. I recommend placing an order in March of 2024 to take delivery at the start of the season.

Cart Path Work and Tee and Bunker Renovation

• We need to consider what work we would like to undertake this fall and in the spring of 2024 and begin the process for, design, specifications, bid documents, and going out to bid.
